



#### May Book Discussion—May 10th, 7:30pm on Zoom



## MAUS

On **Tuesday, May 10 at 7:30pm**, the Temple Isaiah Book Group will discuss the Pulitzer Prize winning graphic novel *MAUS* by Art Spiegelman. We will be discussing the book as a work of literature, as well as the history of book banning in this country.

Recently, a Tennessee school barred students from reading *MAUS*, which had previously been included in its 8th grade curriculum on the Holocaust. According to the American Library Association, the pace of book banning has accelerated rapidly recently. During the course of our discussion, we will consider the reasons given by the school for the ban of *MAUS* and the larger historical context of book bans in this country, particularly in schools.

The discussion will also include a consideration of the special issues raised by the increasingly popular formats of graphic novels and animation in portraying the hardship of real world events.

Come join us for a lively discussion. All are Welcome. Zoom information will be provided the day prior to the event.
