

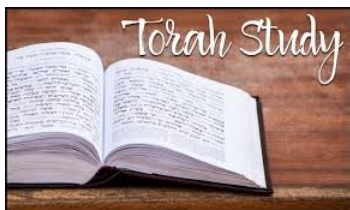

As part of an outreach to the LGBTQ community, we will host a forum with representatives from PFLAG on **Sunday, October 23rd at 2:00pm.**

PFLAG, an acronym for Parents and Friends of Lesbians and Gays, is a national advocacy group founded 50 years ago by Jeanne Manford following a historic march with her son, a prominent gay activist, at the 1972 Christopher Street Liberation Day March. Her commitment would lead to a meeting of parents, LGBTQ people, and allies just nine months later—a meeting that would result in the formation of PFLAG. While the organization offers a variety of services to the LGBTQ community, its primary focus is support for parents and friends of the community. The Long Island chapter serves Nassau and Suffolk counties.

The forum will provide information about the LGBTQ community in today's environment and a discussion about the gender pronouns currently in use. Representatives of PFLAG will also present their own very personal and compelling stories about what brought them to the organization. There will be ample opportunity for questions and discussion.

The forum will be held in person and available online via Zoom. There is no charge to attend and light refreshments will be served. The Zoom link will be emailed to all members of Temple Isaiah. Any other members of our community interested in the link should call or email the Temple office.

We plan to follow the forum by hosting periodic meetings of Parents and Friends of the LGBTQ community, providing a safe space for discussion and sharing.

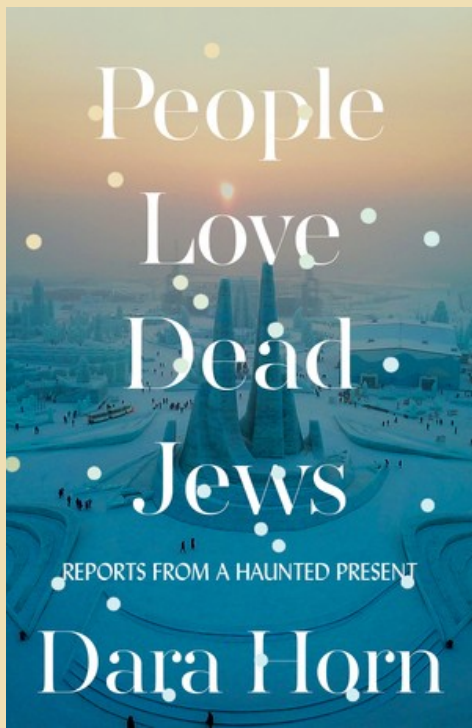
